The Scottish Cup was a hard fought event traditionally held at Castle Hill RSL. This was again a reversal of the prior year's result (if I'm not mistaken) with City Tatts 2 defeating Castle Hill RSL team 1. Congratulations also to C Tatts 2 for their convincing win.

Team entry forms

Team entry fees

I would ask please that these be paid promptly into the Bendigo Bank competition account and advise David McMahon with cc to me please, as to when this has been done, thank you. I presume you would all be aware of the relevant a/c details (same as last year's).

Notification of match scores

Again, the 2023 scoresheet template form will also be shortly emailed to all team captains. I again request hosting Captains to please complete and provide these a.s.a.p. promptly on the completion of each round's play to myself by email (not SMS) as an attachment as that enables me to distribute early results the next morning. I would greatly appreciate being able to avoid chasing Captains for results on Wednesday mornings, thank you.

In terms of media notification, in the absence of any interest and ability to communicate in any way with previously notified (over many years) suburban papers, I am looking at other avenues to disseminate results and would appreciate any support from Team captains and clubs where this may be achieved.

Now that we certainly appear to be all but past the significant impacts of Covid-19, I am hoping that we can encourage hosting club venues to provide some supper though understand that we are still to discuss this shortly.
